

5111.2 Admission – Adult Education/Post-Secondary

The Board of Education guarantees that all vocational opportunities are accessible to all students, employees and the general public without regard to race, color, creed, national origin, affectional or sexual orientation, atypical hereditary cellular blood trait, limited English skills, liability for service in the Armed Services of the United States, any individual or handicap.

Admission into any adult program at CCTEC shall be open for any Cumberland County resident in accordance with the guidelines for the specific program in which the individual is enrolling. Specific programs may have criteria required by the state or another governing body and can't be modified by the Board of Education.

As space permits, admission to adult programs may be granted to students who are not residents of Cumberland County and who meet all guidelines for the specific program in which the individual is enrolling. Additional fees may be assessed.

Adult students are defined as those individuals 18 years of age and older who hold a high school diploma, GED or are enrolled within a GED program. Documentation shall be required.

The Board of Education directs the Superintendent or designee to establish curriculum and procedures for all Adult Education Programming.
