

**SCHOOL-PARENT COMPACT – Cumberland County Technical Education Center**

The Cumberland County Technical Education Center **and** the parents of the students participating in activities, services, and programs funded by Title I Part A of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) (participating children), agree that this compact outlines how the parents, the entire school staff, and the students will share the responsibility for improved student academic achievement and the means by which the school and parents will build and develop a partnership that will help children achieve the State's high standards.

**School Responsibilities**

- Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the State's student academic achievement standards as follows: The Cumberland County Technical Education Center offers students a rigorous curriculum that exceeds the State's requirements for a diploma.
- Provide parents with frequent reports on the student's progress. Specifically, the school will provide reports as follows: progress reports every 5 weeks and report cards every 9 weeks.
- Provide parents reasonable access to staff during non-instructional periods. In addition, parents may communicate with staff through email and voicemail.
- Provide parents opportunities to participate in their student's education process through various committees and school functions.

**Recommended Parent Responsibilities**

- Provide the student with a quiet space to complete homework and afterschool studies.
- Provide the student with academic support at home.
- Promoting positive use of the student's extracurricular time.
- Utilizing Genesis to view the student's grades, attendance, and discipline record on a daily basis.
- On-going communication with the student's teachers.

**Recommended Student Responsibilities**

- Complete all homework assignments.
- Utilize S.M.A.R.T. period to receive additional support from teachers.
- Read outside of school time.
- Communicate regularly with parent/guardian regarding all school correspondence and functions.
